



## **Lakewood Christian School iPad User Agreement**

### **IPAD PURPOSE**

The incorporation of iPads in the classroom is intended to facilitate the speed and efficiency of instruction as well as train our students to be extremely technologically proficient in modern techniques and applications. Much care has been given, much research has been done, much staff training has been completed and much labor has been spent in setting up this endeavor. With that in mind the following rules are crucial to our success.

Students whose I-Pads are left unattended will be fined \$5 on the first offense, \$10 on the second offense and \$20 and a meeting with their parent upon a third offense. Parents, please let your children pay their own fines. Paying their fines for them will not help us make them more responsible.

By signing below, I agree to follow all rules and restrictions set forth by Lakewood Christian School for the use of indicated devices and applications.

All devices, applications, and software are the property of Lakewood Christian School and are to be used for educational purposes only.

This agreement will be reviewed and agreed upon on an annual basis.

As part of the iPad checkout procedure, all iPad users must attend a mandatory iPad Introductory training provided.

Purchasing of applications “Apps” will be done through the designated “Program Facilitator”. Purchasing of “Apps” made by an individual will not be allowed.

All approved “Apps” will be purchased using a school authorized iTunes account.

All iPad “Apps” use agreements are to be followed as written by organization policy and legal license agreements by the application vendor.

iPads shall not be connected to or synchronized with any computer,

All iPad devices are subject to random inspection by Lakewood Christian School staff, Program Facilitator, or supervisor at any time.

Default Lakewood Christian School settings are not to be modified.

iPads will not be removed from their protective cases.

Bring the iPad to Lakewood Christian School every school day with a fully charged battery.

Keep the iPad with you or within your sight at all times.

Do not let anyone use the iPad other than your parents or guardians.

Adhere to Lakewood Christian School Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) at all times. When in doubt, ask a member of the Technology Team or a teacher.

Report any problems, damage or theft immediately to a member of the Technology Team or a teacher.

Provided Gaggie e-mail accounts will be used for all e-mail between students and between students and teachers.

### **DAMAGES**

If the iPad and/or assigned additional equipment (power cord, case, adaptor, etc) is lost, stolen or damaged because of my negligence, I will be personally responsible for all cost associated with its repair and maintenance.

Broken iPads will be repaired by Lakewood Christian School Technology Team.

First instance of damage in the first 12 months will result in a \$50 charge.

Second instance of damage in the first 12 months will result in a \$50 charge.

Any damage occurring after the second instance of damage, or after the first 12 months will result in a \$600 charge or actual cost of repairs, whichever is less.

Ownership of the iPad will be transferred to a withdrawing or graduating student with 4 years of iPad usage.

Students graduating or withdrawing with less than 4 years of usage may purchase the iPad at a cost of \$600, minus \$150 per year for each year the iPad was used by the student at Lakewood.

### **GENERAL CARE**

Do not do anything to the iPad that will permanently alter it in any way.

Do not remove any serial numbers or identification placed on the iPad.

Keep the equipment clean.

The cases may be modified with adhesive material (taped on decor, stickers, etc)

## PERSONAL HEALTH & SAFETY

Do not provide your personal information to anyone over the Internet.

Do not share your passwords with anyone.

Keep the ipad in a secure location when it is not at school.

Failure to abide by the terms and conditions of this agreement may result in removal of the device from the classroom program.
